For laminate, cork, wood and stone floors, we recommend hard floor castors (type W) as well as a protective mat. You can get these wheels at a hardware store. We cannot be held responsible for any damage in the event of non-compliance. 4: Classic relax seat can be placed against a wall. Nevertheless, it is necessary to provide at least 0.3 m distance with it in order to be able to deploy your seat correctly.
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STORAGE AND CLEANING	1: A seat will naturally change shape and appearance as the padding sags or shifts over time. In order to prolong the shape of your product and evenly distribute wear, it is strongly recommended: • Turn the cushions over regularly, if possible, • To smooth the surface of the seats immediately after prolonged use and to massage the cushions to restore their swelling. 2: Your seat fabric will have a natural tendency to pill. This is not a defect if: • Pilling can easily be removed or fade over time, • The number of pills does not significantly affect the aesthetics of your product. 3: Carefully remove the dust. Use a soft and clean damp cloth with soapy water. Do not use abrasive cleaning products or solvents.
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
